A Typical Day

- Morning Welcome Warm greetings and time to settle in.
- Free Play & Learning Activities –
 Children choose from exciting areas: construction, role play, art, reading corners, and more.
- Outdoor Adventures Fresh air and active play in our outdoor spaces.
- Circle Time Songs, stories, and group activities that bring us together.
- Snack Time Healthy snacks shared with friends.
- Focused Activities Small group learning led by staff, tailored to children's interests.
- Closing Together Calm activities and reflection before home time.

Safegaurding

Your child's safety, welfare and wellbeing are at the heart of everything we do.

At Netherfield Pre-school we create a safe, welcoming environment where children can play, learn and grow.

All staff are trained, suitability checked and supported to keep children safe every day.



What we do to keep children safe

- Trained staff regular safeguarding training and paediatric first aid.
- **Safe recruitment** DBS checks and references for all team members.
- Clear procedures arrival/collection, medication and illness, supervision and emergency plans.
- **Risk assessments** daily checks for indoor and outdoor areas and trips.
- Confidential records concerns recorded responsibly and shared only when necessary.
- Inclusion & support we work with families and agencies to support every child.

The Main Room

Our spacious, welcoming main room is the heart of our pre-school. Bright, engaging, and well-equipped, it offers a wide range of play and learning areas – from role play and construction, to creative arts, early literacy, and group activities.

Outdoor Play

Admissions & Fees

Joining Netherfield Pre-School

We would love to welcome your family to Netherfield Pre-school. Our simple admissions process is designed to give you the information you need, help your child settle confidently, and make sure the sessions you choose work for your family.

How to apply

- 1. Phone or email us to arrange a visit and a tour. We will show you around, introduce you to the team, and answer your questions.
- Complete a registration form (we can email or give you a printed copy). This secures your child place on our waiting list.
- 3. **Visit and settling-in session.** We offer short, supported settling sessions so your child gets used to the room and key person.
- 4.**Confirm sessions & paperwork.** When a place is offered, we will ask for the completed documents.

Sessions & Opening Hours

- Opening days: Monday-Friday, 9:00 3:00
- Term time only
- Flexible options: We offer a mix of morning, afternoon and full-day sessions to fit family needs (subject to availability).

Payments & Notice

- Invoices issued termly in advance.
 Payment is accepted by bank transfer and childcare vouchers.
- Notice period: We require 4 weeks written notice to change or end sessions. Fees are payable during the notice period.
- Late or missed payments: We reserve the right to charge interest on overdue accounts and may withhold places after repeated missed payments (we will always contact you first).

- Opening Hours: 9 3pm Mon-Fri, term time only
- **Sessions**: Morning, afternoon, or full day whatever works best for your family.
- **Clothing**: We recommend comfy clothes and a spare set (for messy play adventures).
- Meals & Snacks: Healthy snacks are provided; children bring a packed lunch for full days.
- Funding: Government-funded hours are available, with extra sessions to suit your needs.
